

- Interested in a variety of experiences beyond a regular high school


Why Attend a Magnet Program?



Admissions



- 8th grade students are eligible to apply for freshman admission into any magnet program.
- To attend, students must be residing in the Cobb County School District
- There is ONE application website for all five academic magnet programs. Pebblebrook & CITA are a little different
- Applicants will be evaluated on demonstrated strengths in the following areas:
 - ◆*Middle school grades
 - **◆*Teacher recommendations**
 - ◆*Standardized test scores

*PSAT or audition scores (based on program)

*Written communication skills (application & essay)

- The PSAT 8/9 test will be administered to all 8th graders in Cobb County middle schools
- This PSAT 8/9 is important and will be considered as part of your Magnet Admissions application
